

Minister of State of Education Mr.Ghulam Farid Kathia visited Dawood College of engineering and Technology

Minister of State of Education Mr.Ghulam Farid Kathia visited Dawood College of engineering and Technology on Monday, November 17, 2008. He was welcomed by The Principal DCET Prof (Dr) Mohammad Nasim who gave a briefing about the college, its different faculties and departments, admission policy and on going developments works. He added that we had reduced class strength from 100 students to maximum class size of 50, for this purpose more classrooms were added.
